Brooklyn with her niece and sister with a disability. Here they had more opportunities to thrive; they could go to school, learn to ride bikes, and get outside. Both have now passed away, and she lives alone, making it more important that she feels safe, alone in her house.

A family member who lives out of town found out about CHS and got in touch with the staff. The results have amazed Ms. Smith. The volunteers cleaned up her yard and, with the help of staff from CHS, made improvements that will allow her to stay in her house. They put up a mailbox post by her door so that she does not have to walk to the street for her mail. They repaired her deck rails, converted her bathtub to a walk-in shower with grab bars, fixed the plumbing,

installed a new sink, and replaced her roof. All in all, volunteers and CHS staff put in four to five solid days of work, morning to night.

The volunteers "were a God-send," said Ms. Smith. Living on Social Security, she couldn't have afforded to hire out the repairs, and the house wasn't safe without them. With the help of CHS, Ms.. Smith is prepared to live out her days in safety and comfort.








